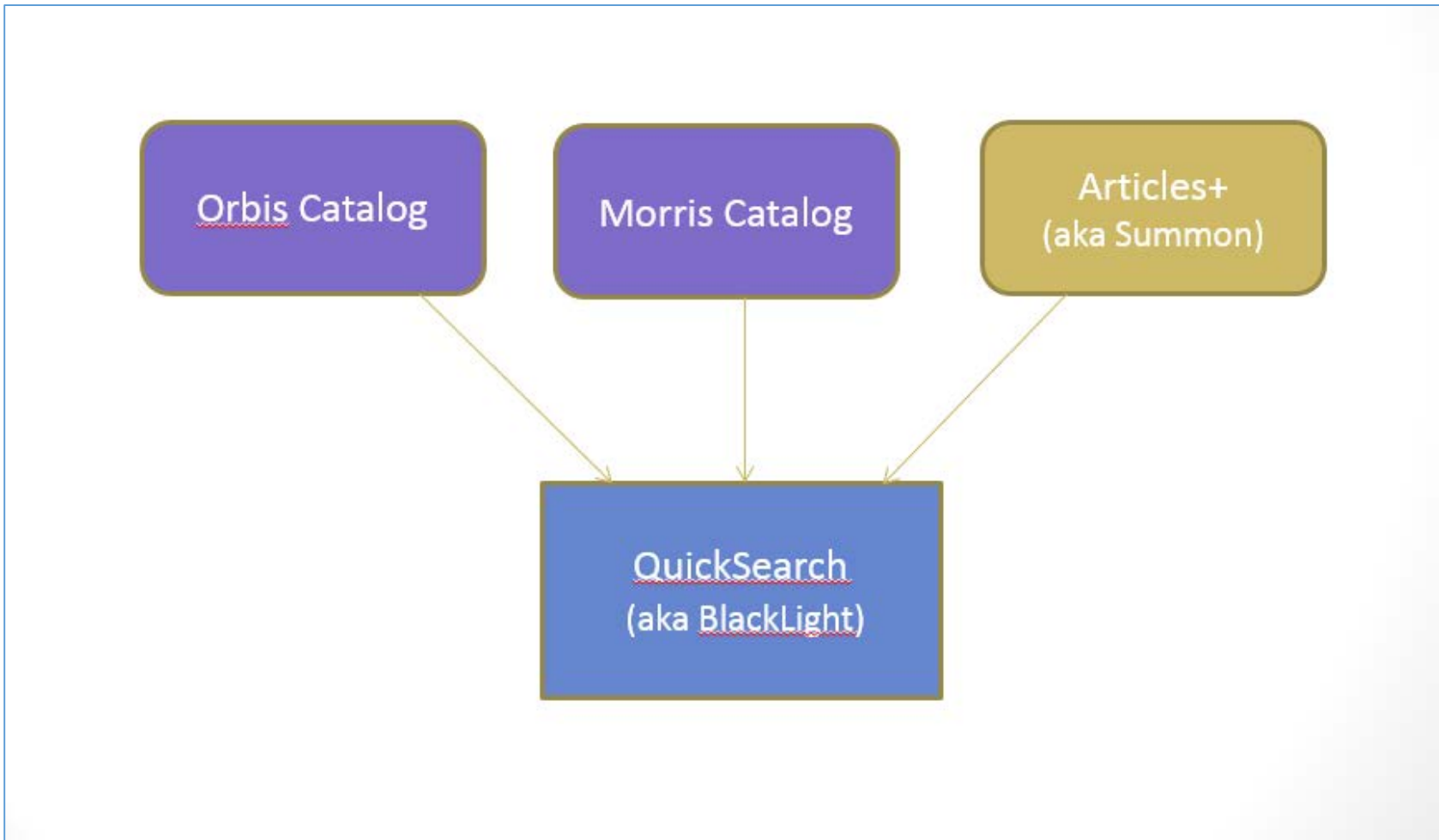


QuickSearch Quick Guide: What's in Quicksearch?



	<b>Books+</b>	<b>Articles+</b>

<b>Data sources</b>	Orbis and Morris catalogs	Articles+ (aka Summon)
<b>Data currency</b>	Bib records = Daily updates, with ingest each morning. Up to 24 delay between Orbis and Books+ Access information = Real time	All data (results and access) = Real time
<b>Index contents</b>	10 million+ bib records	2 billion+ records (metadata differs, largely article-level)
<b>Ebook coverage</b>	All licensed ebooks	All major packages; individual reference works; 850,000+ unique titles
<b>Search results</b>	Title level	Title, article, and chapter level
<b>Major differences from native interfaces</b>	Improved relevancy ranking in keyword searches within QuickSearch  Ability to include/exclude results using “is/is not” logic	The QuickSearch <i>interface</i> does not include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fuller abstracting and citation info</li> <li>• Predictive search text</li> <li>• Image and news roll-ups (buried in results)</li> <li>• Exclude filters (no “is/is not”)</li> </ul>
